Characterization 3 Dimensional Character Character

The "three-dimensional character" formation came from playwright Lajos Egri's "three dimensions of character" model, which he discussed in his book *The Art of Dramatic Writing*. Egri's idea is that, in order to thoroughly conceive a character, a writer should consider three dimensions: that character's physiology, psychology, and sociology.

Main characters must be three dimensional to be relatable. Non essential characters, who either help or hinder the main cast, can be two dimensional. In other words, two dimensional characters are reflexive; they don't grow, develop, or learn; they either introduce an obstacle or a solution, but they're not complete.
